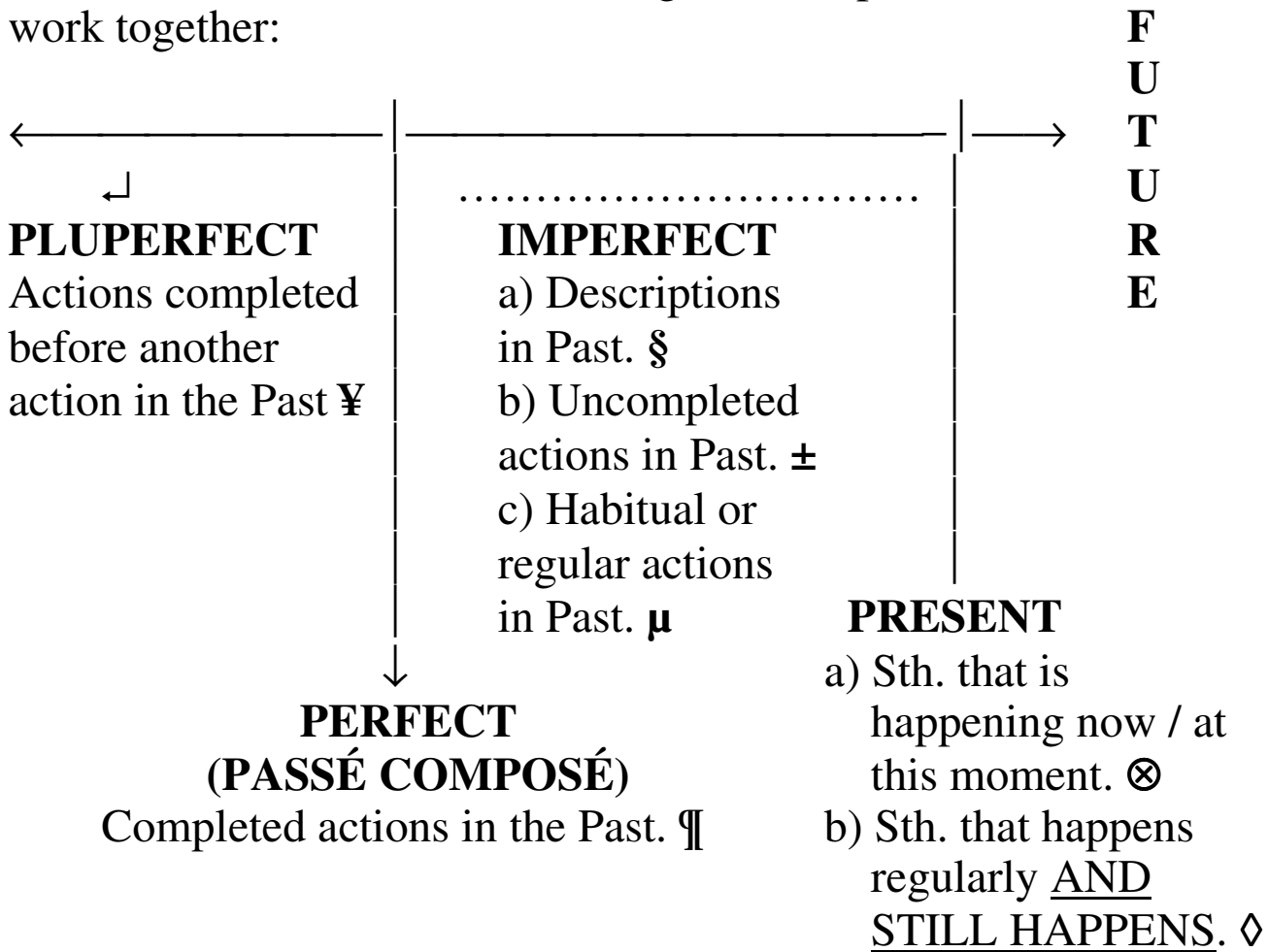


# THE "TIME LINE"
